- Share best practice

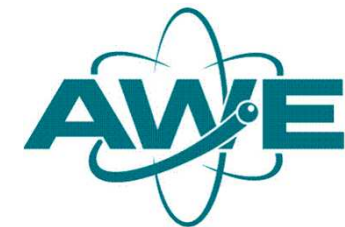

A Supply Chain Mapping Good Practice Guide was formally published on 01/09/17

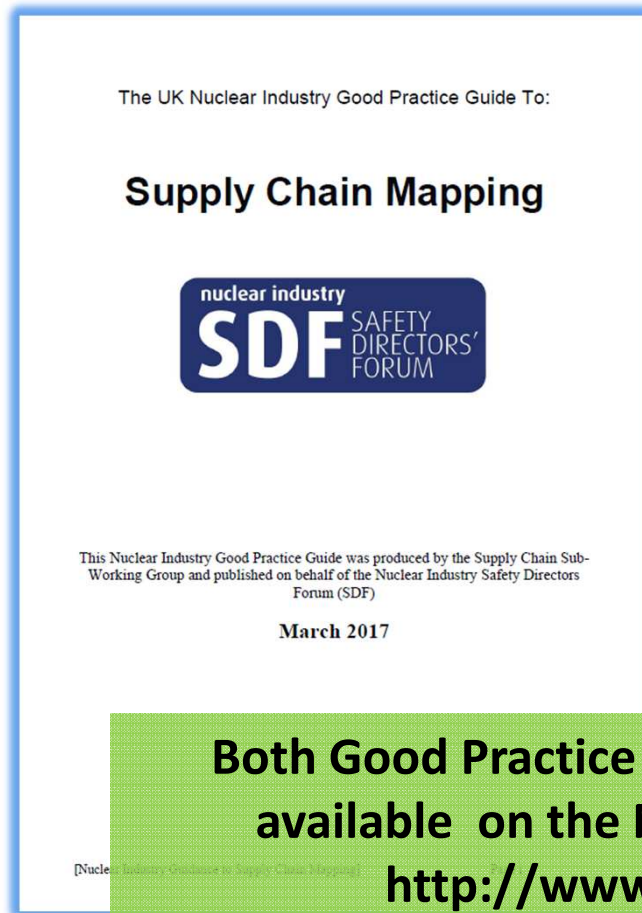
A Counterfeit Material video and supporting material was formally launched on 06/07/17
