

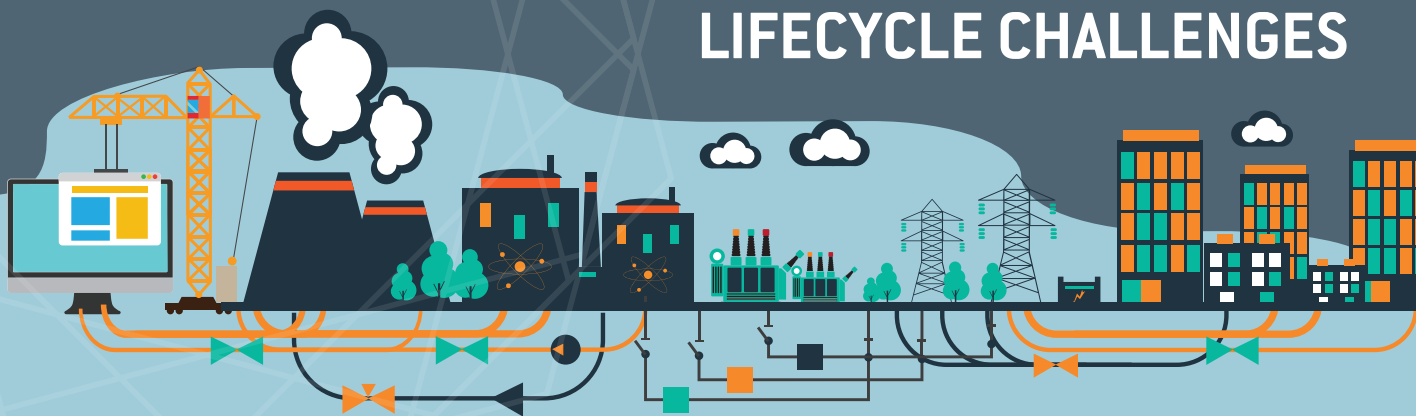

SMRs can be a part of the UK industrial strategy of creating a decentralised energy market and driving energy efficiency, as the UK transitions to a low-carbon economy.
