# Directions

## Rail

The nearest railway station—Liverpool Lime Street—is a 10 minute taxi ride away from the venue and serves both local and national destinations including London, Birmingham, Manchester and Glasgow.

## Road

The Rum Warehouse is less than 5 miles from the M62, from where you simply follow signs to the City Centre and Dock attractions; or enter the post code L3 0AN into a SatNav. There is limited on site parking, available on a first come first served basis. Parking is chargeable.

## Air

Liverpool John Lennon airport is 20 minutes away by taxi. Typically a taxi fare should cost around £20-30. Trains leave regularly from the airport to Liverpool city centre stations.

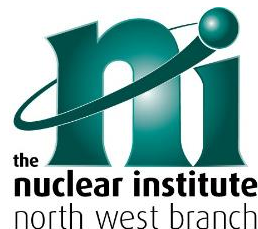
