#### Overview:

The Annual Day Seminar and Dinner is the YGN's flagship event which moves to a new location each year and provides the opportunity for delegates to hear the latest developments in our sector from leading experts as well as developing a professional network of contacts. Previous events have seen approximately 300 young professionals representing 30+ companies from across the industry.
