#### Terms and conditions

- 1 Any university, college or government registered training provider <sup>1</sup> running programmes that include significant nuclear-related content may apply for membership of the Nuclear Institute as an Education Affiliate.
- 2 Membership runs on a calendar year and is payable on 1 January each year.
- 3 If an Education Affiliate member withdraws from membership any accreditations held will not be renewed.
- 4 The Nuclear Institute reserves the right to withdraw membership, and all benefits associated with this grade, if payment is not received promptly.
- 5 Education Affiliate membership is offered on a department basis. This entitles the department to sign up all students enrolled on taught programmes for free Affiliate membership. This excludes students on research degrees unless otherwise agreed.
- 6 Education Affiliate members can sign up students for free NI membership, as follows:
  - a. undergraduate/postgraduate students irrespective of the degree they have enrolled on

- b. students enrolled on programmes at levels 2-5 as a pathway to employment in nuclear
- c. PhD candidates are excluded from this arrangement, unless otherwise agreed.
- d. In order to benefit from free membership, students should sign up via the Nuclear Institute website using your institution's Education Affiliate enrolment code
- 7 Education Affiliate membership includes free Associate membership for two representatives of the department; this will not cover professional membership fees
- 8 Education Affiliate membership does not infer Nuclear Institute accreditation or endorsement of courses. The Institute offers a separate, optional course approval service that requires submission of an application form and supporting information. Further details are available on request.
- 9 Subject to separate agreement, the NI will enable Education Affiliate members to offer discounted <sup>2</sup> NI Associate membership to employed participants on part-time or short duration courses.
