Directions

Rail

The nearest railway station—Manchester Oxford Road—is directly opposite the hotel and serves destinations in South Manchester and the North of England, including Blackpool, Preston, and Leeds. Manchester Piccadilly is the main station for the city and is a 10-minute walk from the hotel (or 5 minutes by taxi), serving London, Edinburgh, Cardiff, and more.

Road

The Principal Manchester is just 3 miles from the M62 to the south, from where you simply follow signs to the University; or enter the post code M60 7HA into a SatNav. There is no onsite parking. Parking is available in local car parks.

Air

Manchester International Airport is about 8 miles, or a 20-minute drive, from The Principal Manchester on Oxford Street. Typically a taxi fare should cost around £20-30.

Trains leave regularly from the airport to Oxford Road and Manchester Piccadilly stations.
